

# Full Arch Replacement

When it comes to replacing your teeth, there are a few options to consider. Each option has its pros and cons, from cost to chewing ability. Replacing your teeth can have an impact on your self confidence. Below are your options that you can discuss with your dentist. It's time to enjoy your smile again!

### Option 1: Implant Supported Fixed Denture

This is the most popular option today. This type of denture is held in place using implants. It is fixed in place using screws so that it cannot be taken in or out. The dentist will need to remove it at regular maintenance intervals when they check the connections. The cost for this treatment is between \$25 to \$30K per arch. And the best part... you can be practically finished in just ONE day!

### Option 2: Implant Supported Snap-On Denture

This is a REMOVABLE option (Option 1 is FIXED in your mouth and never comes out). You save some cost, but because it's removable it's not quite as stable or natural feeling. This is a popular option for patients who want something a lot better than regular dentures, but don't care that their teeth are removable instead of fixed. This can cost \$8,000 to \$25,000.

### Option 3: Regular Complete Denture

This is the cheapest option, but also the most limiting. They cost \$500 to \$5,000. Regular dentures move, slide, and rub on your gums causing soreness as well as smiling and eating problems. The best way to think of regular dentures: these are soup, fish, and oatmeal eating teeth, not steak eating teeth.
